


BEACON RISE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Activity	Impact
Additional Teaching Assistants	Gap between FSM and non FSM pupils is closing.
Pupil Premium Leader release time	All pupil premium pupils attainment, progress, emotional and social need is monitored regularly and intervention is put into place to ensure the gap is reduced.
Vulnerable Pupil Group	All pupils who are facing difficult and challenging circumstances are identified and supported socially, emotionally and academically to ensure all that they thrive in our school. This can include TAC meetings, CP plan, SAF meetings and our Family Liaison Officer.
School Trips Subsidy	All pupils who are in receipt of pupil premium attend all school and residential trips if they wish.
Play Leader	Pupils with specific social and emotional needs are met at lunchtimes.
Nurture Intervention	Pupils who are facing difficult circumstances have their social, emotional and/or mental health needs met through tailored 1:1 or small group nurture intervention.
HomeBR – Breakfast and After School Clubs	All pupils in receipt of pupil premium who require a place at Breakfast or After School Club are allocated a place.

Family Liaison Officer	An extension to our Family Liaison Officer's hours has enabled the needs of more families to be met by planning and organising individual meetings, carrying out referrals and arranging coffee mornings and setting up Maths and English parent workshops.
